	you are diabetic, pregnant or nursing please mention this when you are booking you opointment. Arrive 15 minutes early to register and always bring your Health Card with you.
	Then you come in for your appointment, enter through the Emergency entrance. Register at the witchboard with your Health Card.

	Do not wear powder, deodorant, perfume or lotions on the day of your examination. Please wear a separate blouse with a shirt or slacks.

_	ALL CT examinations, please bring previous x-ray/CT/Ultrasound reports if done at another facility of stay off your medication before the CT scan unless directed by your physician.
	CT scan without lodinated IV Contrast: No preparation required
	CT scan with Oral Contrast: Please arrive 90 minutes before your appointment time.
	pper G.I. Series/Barium Swallows: Nothing to eat or drink after midnight. Do not eat or drink nything until after your examination. Do not chew gum.

Bowel Preparation:

*1 Box Pico-Salax – the box contains 2 packets of bowel preparation. You will need to take them both. You can pick this up at the pharmacy.

□ **Small Bowel Follow Through**: Please follow the preparation below.

Day Before the Examination:

- 1. Eat a normal breakfast
- 2. Clear fluids for the rest of the day (no solid food or milk products).
- 3. a) Take 1st packet of Pico-Salax at about 11:00 a.m. mix it in a 150 mL mug of cold water. You must continue to stir while drinking the mug of Pico-Salax to ensure all the laxative has dissolved. Drink one glass of water (or more) each hour over the next 3 hours to replace fluids lost throughout the cleansing process.
 - b) Take 2nd packet of Pico-Salax at about 3:00 p.m. mix it in a 150 mL mug of cold water. Again, continue to stir while drinking to ensure the laxative has dissolved. Drink one glass of water (or more) each hour over the next 3 hours.
- 4. Liquid dinner of clear fluids (Clear Liquids: apple juice, chicken broth, jell-o, popsicles, water, black tea or coffee, etc).
- 5. Nothing to eat or drink after midnight Do not eat or drink anything in the morning.

The exam may take 2-4 hours to complete, so please be prepared to stay that long.

■ **Barium Enema**: Please follow the preparation below.

Preferred Bowel Preparation:

*Bisacodyl Laxative (such as Dulcolax) – 4 tablets (5 mg each).

*1 Box of Pico-Salax – the box contains 2 packets of bowel preparation. You will need to take them both. You can pick both this and the Bisacodyl up at the pharmacy

Day Before the Examination:

- 1. Clear liquids the day prior to the procedure (apple juice, jell-o, chicken broth, Gatorade, popsicles, water, black tea or coffee, etc). No Milk products.
- 2. At 8:00 a.m. take 4 Bisacodyl (Dulcolax) tablets by mouth with 1-2 glasses of water.
- 3. a) Take 1st packet of Pico-Salax at about 11:00 a.m. mix in a 150 mL mug of cold water. You must continue to stir while drinking the mug of Pico-Salax to ensure all the laxative has dissolved. Drink one glass of water (or more) each hour over the next 3 hours to replace fluids last throughout the cleansing process.
 - b) Take 2nd packet of Pico-Salax at about 3:00 p.m. mix in a 150 mL mug of cold water. You must continue to stir while drinking the mug of Pico-Salax to ensure all the laxative has dissolved. Again, drink one glass of water (or more) each hour over the next 3 hours.
- 4. Nothing to eat or drink after midnight or in the morning. Diabetic patients may have a small breakfast on the day of the examination.
